## Church Update Re: Coronavirus

*"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Philipians 4:6-7.*

We continue to monitor the Government of Saskatchewan's advice regarding safety measures in response to the COVID-19 outbreak. At this time, the Public Health Agency of Canada has assessed the public health risk associated with COVID-19 as low for the general population, but this could change quickly. There is an increased risk of more severe outcomes for Canadians 65 and over, and those with compromised immune systems or underlying medical conditions.

### **We will continue our usual gatherings, but ask that the following precautions be taken (in accordance with Government of Saskatchewan Guidelines):**

- If you feel ill please avoid attending. Feel free to contact Pastor Kevin or a deacon (Deb, Andy, Marvin, Beth) via a text, phone, or e-mail ([crmc@sasktel.net](mailto:crmc@sasktel.net)) and they'll give you a shout the following week to see how you're doing, and if you're interested, a short recap of the sermon, and prayer for you over the phone.
- Substitute handshakes and hugs for elbow bumps, enthusiastic waves, or saying an encouraging word at a distance (ex. "Nice shoes!")
- Follow proper hand/cough hygiene.
